

SCHOOL UNIFORM REQUIREMENTS

The wearing of uniform is compulsory and a uniform list is detailed below. We ask for the constant vigilance and co-operation of parents in helping us maintain the standard of appearance of the uniform.

SCHOOL UNIFORM	
Blazer	Navy blue with integral school badge.
Blouse/Shirt	White short-sleeved reverse collar cotton blouse or white cotton shirt.
Skirt	Tartan, knee length kilt.
Trousers	Plain navy blue tailored school trousers or charcoal grey tailored school trousers. Trousers should be smart, suit-style and have a waistband. Extremes of style must not be worn. They should not be tight-fitting around the legs. Similarly, they should not be “drain-pipe” flared or “boot-cut” in style. Jeans/denim must never be worn.
Socks	Plain navy blue, knee length with kilts or plain dark grey or black socks with trousers.
Tights	Opaque, navy blue.
Cardigan/Pullover	Navy blue with integral school badge.
T-Shirt	White, short-sleeved (optional: to be worn underneath blouse/shirt)
Shoes	Black and low heeled (not fashion platform shoes or trainer styled). Trainers are only to be worn for sports, not for travel to and from school. No canvas shoes are to be worn. No large decorative buckles are allowed and black laces only. No boots or ankle boots.
Winter Coats	Raincoats – plain navy blue or black (denim, suede, patent, leather or sheepskin are not allowed). No fur trim.
Summer Coats	Lightweight waterproof jackets, plain navy blue or black.
Scarves	Only plain navy or black may be worn. Head scarves must be plain navy blue.
Hats	Plain navy blue or black “Beanie” style only.
Nails	Short nails. Nail varnish and false nails, of any kind, are not permitted.
Make-up	Make up is not permitted. This includes foundation, mascara and any artificial facial enhancements.
Earrings	One pair of stud earrings in lower earlobes 5mm in diameter max – plain gold, silver or clear diamond.
Jewellery	No additional jewellery except a faith necklace.

Hair Styles	Hair styles must be appropriate to school. Noticeably extreme cuts or dyed colours are not allowed e.g. shaved, razored, mohawks, designs/patterns, coloured streaks, unnatural dyed colours and excessively long hairstyles, as examples are not permitted.
Hair Bands/Clips	“Alice” band / small clips / hair bands and ribbons must be navy blue, black or white only.
School Bag	Rucksack or messenger style school bags, NO handbags.
PE Kit	Short-sleeved navy blue polo sports shirt, navy blue shorts, reversible games top, navy blue socks, navy blue ¼ zip sweatshirt (optional) and navy blue track pants (optional) all to be furnished with the integral school badge, trainers and football boots. Please note PE footwear does not include hightop, plimsoll or skateboard style leisure shoes.

School Bag: Appropriate ‘school bags’ only. Handbags are not permitted to school. Rucksack or ‘Messenger’ style school bags tend to be the most robust and practical to carry books and PE kit. A sturdy bag will ensure that books, which are the property of the school, are not damaged when taken home for homework. Pupils will be held responsible for the good order and care of school books and will be required to replace any books which may be lost or damaged.

All uniform must be CLEARLY named. FULL FIRST NAME and SURNAME inside each garment and INITIALS outside.

SIXTH FORM STUDENTS:

Sixth Form students are role models for younger students and are expected to set an example to the rest of the school through their business like dress. The intention of the Sixth Form dress code is to dress as if they were working in a smart office environment. A Sixth Former should be able to leave the school site and immediately attend a formal interview without having to change their appearance. Smart skirts/dress/trousers/shirt/blouse. A jacket must be worn. Formal occasions tie to be worn.

No jeans, leggings, trainers, no cropped tops, off the shoulder or t-shirts. No extremes of hairstyle. Jewellery is limited to modest earrings, necklaces and bracelets; in particular no facial piercing is allowed. No artificial facial enhancements.
