



## Staying Covid-19 Secure in The Douay Martyrs Catholic Secondary School canteen.

- ✓ We have carried out a covid-19 risk assessment with the kitchen staff.
- ✓ We have cleaning hand washing and hygiene procedures in line with guidance.
- ✓ We have taken all reasonable steps to help students and staff.
- ✓ We have taken all reasonable steps to maintain a 2-metre distance in the canteen
- ✓ We have put in place a procedure for sanitizing all cutlery, drinking cups and trays.
- ✓ The school has stagger breaktime so that the number of staff and students using the canteen hall is spread out by removing some chairs from tables to force a safe safety distance.
- ✓ We have removed self-service tongs where possible.
- ✓ We pre-wrap loose foods such as fruit to discourage staff and students touching and then placing back on display.
- ✓ Regularly sanitize hand contact points such as buttons on till machines and self-service drinks area.
