Any students who fail to achieve a Grade 4 or above in either English Language or Mathematics will be required to re-sit the GCSE level qualification as part of their 6<sup>th</sup> Form course offer.

In addition to the School's Admissions criteria\*

All Year 11 students from The Douay Martyrs Catholic Secondary School will be considered for a place in the Sixth Form if they have met the minimum entry requirements for entry to the Sixth Form **and** for the courses on offer. (See prospectus for details).

In addition to places reserved for the school's own students, the governors propose to admit a minimum of 15 external students annually to its Sixth Form, provided they meet the required academic qualifications. If there are more external applications than places available at the school then the school oversubscription criteria will apply in accordance with the criteria for admission to Year 7.

Unsuccessful applicants will be given reasons related to the oversubscription criteria and advised of their right to appeal.

All students study Core R.E. once a week. The Extended Project qualification is available for suitable candidates.
